

Gas Service Station
309 E. Irving Park Road, Bensenville, IL

The City of Chicago is seeking interested individuals or groups to relocate and rehabilitate the Domestic style, Tudor revival Gas Service Station located at 309 E. Irving Park Road in Bensenville, Illinois. The 2,079 square foot structure was built between 1931 and 1939 and includes 4 service bays; it is constructed from wire-cut brick, common bond brick and cinder block with decorative limestone accents. The selected individual or group will have 90 days to remove the entire building from the site. The station must be rehabilitated according to the Secretary of the Interior's *Standards for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings*. The City of Chicago will donate the building and provide a monetary contribution not to exceed demolition costs (estimated at **\$17,250**) to assist in relocation.
