Susan is past chairman and currently a director of Mount Sinai Hospital and Health System and Chair of the Foster McGaw Prize Committee of the American Hospital Association. She has served on the National Parks Foundation, the Chicago Board of Health, the Environmental Defense Fund and is currently on the Executive Committee for the International Human Rights Watch. She has received awards from the American Jewish Committee and Alexian Brothers Medical Center.

Lew serves as Trustee of the Art Institute, the Museum of Contemporary Art (former President), Goodman Theater (Honorary President) and the Chicago Council on Global Affairs. In 2000, he received the National Medal of Arts for his advocacy of a theater district in Chicago. He has honorary doctorates from Columbia University and Governors State University and has served as Chairman of the U.S. Advisory Committee on Public Diplomacy.
